Info: Senior Aged and Disability Limited Income Exemptions

Last month the Governor signed legislation that raises the maximum income eligibility to qualify for the Senior Aged (4180) and Disability Limited Income (4193) exemptions to \$50,000. The previous maximum, since 2009, was \$29,000.
