- 3. Privilege of the Floor Numerous Tioga County Residents spoke towards the rebuttal letter to support the Crestwood's LPG Storage Project in Schuyler County that was submitted by Ms. Gerri Wiley. All the residents spoke against the project and that it is not the Tioga County IDA's responsibility to make a decision about another county; the Crestwood LPG Storage Project in Schuyler County is not the same type of project that is located in Tioga County; the project in Schuyler County is a salt cavern storage project. Many of the residents spoke of the safety issues regarding this type of project; in the rebuttal letter, catastrophic events w/ salt storage caverns were noted as well as the concerns that it may jeopardize the environment, put tourism attractions such as wineries at risk as well as endangering the water supply.
- 4. **Correspondence** Rebuttal letter for Crestwood LPG Storage Project in Schuyler County was submitted by Ms. Gerri Wiley, distributed to the board members, emails and phones calls requesting the IDA not to supply a support letter were also received.
- 5. E-Site Development Project Update had meeting with D. D'Attilio, D. Chase, R. Kelsey, A. Gowan, L. Tinney, and R. Fiato regarding the cost and timing of the project. After a conversation with Nelson Leenhouts from Home Leasing, Delta will provide new layout plans that move project down closer to 434. Delta Engineers will also go back and revisit site development and set perimeters of layout cost and come up with new figure of what the cost will be for the IDA to implement the infrastructure. This project could be the signature project for this site. Nelson Leenhouts needs answer as soon as possible so he can move forward with securing financing for his project. David from Delta Engineering inquired about whether or not the IDA would need an easement at Ruth Street to connect to the existing water line; what size tank would be needed for the fire-fighting requirements for Nelson's project and find out if the current booster system in Hallstead can handle new development on E-Site. A new layout design could eliminate an extensive access road, water tank on hill for single unit vs. whole development needs to be determined so Delta can go back to United Water and find out the

requirements needed to supply water to project. Also need to find out if United Water will contribute to project since it will help the current water system and the demands that are already placed on the water system.
