Our annual dairy promotion event was held at Engelbert's Farm this year drawing a crowd of over 1,000 people!











TC ARG had another great year of collaboration! We began the year by reviewing the county's Agriculture and Farmland Protection Plan (2015) and the strategies laid out for the ARG and collective partners to contribute to the implementation of the plan. We were glad to see success on many tasks, made note of areas we should look at and started collecting edits for a plan update in the future. This year we hosted several speakers that prompted great discussions and new action items. We heard a state of the Chesapeake Bay TMDL update, information and updates from Tioga County Sustainability/Recycling/Waste, the Tioga County Ag and Farmland Protection Board and NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), as well as, a tour of CCE's Hilltop Community Farm location and updates about their new incubator farmer program. We spent time discussing issues affecting our farmers such as solar facilities, ag tire disposal, dairy industry, agrotourism opportunities, land access and hiring on-farm help. Our annual outreach event, Sundaes at the Farm, brought over 1,000 people to a local dairy farm for free educational activities. We also tabled at the Tioga County Fair to promote local agriculture with fun children's activities. This year we created a Youth Engagement Committee to bring educators in our local schools to the table to share our resources, help them with issues they are facing and overall increase the engagement between our group and schools. And finally, this year we decided to start an ARG newsletter! The newsletter will have information, updates and opportunities from the ARG partners for the Tioga County ag community!
