Crown Cork and Seal: Town of Nichols operations: Line 1 is fully operational with 40,000 gallons of water per day; Line 2 is not expected to be fully operational until September 2017; and Line 3 is expected sometime soon. J. Bellis reported there is a lot of pre-treatment with little to no sludge. SRBC is monitoring. J. Bellis reported some improvements are needed to the vault. A.
