2021 HIGHLIGHTS

- Even though 2021 turned out to be the second straight year of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Clerk's Office and the DMV were able to continue operating as usual and even saw an overall increase in revenue.
- The revenue from the Clerk's Office increased by about 19% over 2020. This increase is attributed to the decrease in interest rates that allowed people to refinance or to buy a new home.
- The DMV also saw an increase in revenue despite being closed for almost two weeks in November due to Covid issues. The overall increase in revenue for 2021 versus 2020 was approximately 12%.
- In February of 2021, the Tioga County Legislature adopted a resolution to move the position of Records Management Officer from the Information Technology and Communications Department to the County Clerk's Office. At that time the duties of managing the fixed assets and records programs were moved to the newly created position of Director of Assets and Records Management.

Here are the highlights of the Assets and Records Management Program from the Director of Assets and Records Management:

- The most significant achievement in records management in 2021 was the inventory of 2,552 cubic feet of County records, the results of which provide greater intellectual control of and accessibility to the collections under our care. The records department accessioned an additional 153 cubic feet of transferred records and destroyed 73 cubic feet of obsolete records.
- A second major initiative of 2021 was a drive toward implementing naming conventions and standardizing records series titles and corresponding retention periods through the establishment of customized department-specific retention schedules. A pilot meeting with the Probation department laid the foundation for this initiative by helping to determine how the records department can best meet the needs of departments and records stewards. Administration of the County's non-capital fixed assets continued as well. In 2021, 142 assets

were added to Munis, 112 were retired, 8 were transferred, and 4 were sold.

• The records department was also awarded funds from the American Rescue Plan to secure the services of a records management consultant to evaluate our current program and design strategies for its advancement.

Goals for 2022

- Expand vital DMV services for Tioga County residents by improving the Owego Office and possibly establishing an additional office in Waverly.
- Continue to improve the records storage and accessibility for all Tioga County Departments.
- Image and protect older obscure Tioga County records currently housed at the Tioga County Clerk's Office.
