Minutes of the March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018 finance committee meeting were read and a motion to approve by Weston, and second by Hollenbeck.

Treasurer McFadden: Gave an update on the 2016 tax foreclosure enforcement process with 91 parcels still unpaid. He shared a personal letter recently sent to 70 owners with a final deadline of April 30<sup>th</sup>.

- Reported that Tioga Downs casino tax revenue for the first quarter 2018 came in at \$312,789. The county also received their first 4% occupancy tax from the Downs hotel of \$7483.

 Shared an executive summary report on the actuarial accrued liability of Tioga County's Postretirement Health care benefits as of December 31, 2017. The expected net OPEB obligation has risen to \$
63,142,557, and will be included in our annual financial statements under the GASB-45 obligation.

- Reviewed the treasurers' office year to date budget performance. Highlighted by the large revenue increase in interest and penalties collected from the many tax redemptions paid in March.

- Will be attending with some staff the annual county finance school in Syracuse May 2-4
