- Installs and repairs traffic signs and posts;
- Makes sign brackets in conformance with state regulations;
- Operates computerized sign applicating equipment;
- Places signs at construction sites;
- Measures and prepares surfaces to be painted;
- Operates equipment used in the painting of streets, crosswalks, and parking areas;
- Cleans and maintains road marking equipment;
- Prepares specifications for contracts for sign materials and supplies;
- May assist in the digging of holes needed for the installation of signs;
- May perform minor maintenance on the departmental truck.
