A copy of the cost benefit analysis provided by the Department of Economic Development and Planning is available in the front of the room for your review. Notice of the hearing was published on April 11th, 2014 in the Press and Sun Bulletin. Each person wishing to speak shall state his or her name. And if you are speaking on behalf of any organization

or entity, please identify that 1 organization or entity. Each speaker shall 2 be given 5 minutes to speak. This hearing 3 shall remain open until 12:30, or longer, 4 5 if public comment warrants. I want to remind you that the purpose 6 of this hearing is to afford you an 7 opportunity to make statements and comments 8 on the application and project plan of the 9 IDA. Your comments will be considered by 10 the IDA in making a decision. This is not 11 12 a question and answer session. So please remember to identify yourself and the 13 14 organization or the entity that you are 15 speaking on behalf of prior to your 16 comments. First I will ask LeeAnn, Director of 17 Economic Development and Planning, to 18 explain the benefits requested by Lockheed 19 Martin. 20 21 MS. TINNEY: My name is LeeAnn 22 Tinney, Director of Economic Development and Planning for Tioga County. This 23 project is related to the Lockheed Martin 24

Owego Mission Systems and Training Portfolio Expansion. Lockheed Martin is proposing the renovation and equipping of existing space at the Lockheed Martin facility located at 1801 State Route 17C, Town of Owego. The renovations will allow for the relocation and merging of heavy machine tool and milling equipment and for the relocation of program specific laboratory space. The projected investment for these renovations are for the purchase of additional equipment, engineering and design fees, and legal and agency fees in the amount of \$19,284,547.

There will be no retention of existing jobs as a result of this project; however, the project will create an anticipated new workforce of 130 employees with an estimated payroll of over \$9 million in 2015. The renovations are estimated to take 10 months to complete.

22The Department of Economic23Development and Planning took a very close24look at the nature of this project and the

opportunity that has been presented to Lockheed Martin, the Town of Owego, and Tioga County. Several important factors to The project will provide consider include: economies of scale that would greatly enhance new business opportunities for Lockheed Martin MST; the project would position Lockheed Martin Owego as a key complex manufacturing location within the Lockheed Martin Corporation and further its current position as a recognized center of excellence for engineering design and development; the project would provide for new opportunities for new production/technician positions in New York's Southern Tier; the project would assist in stabilizing the employment base at the Owego facility and assist the company in maintaining and growing its large pool New York State based suppliers and vendors; and the project would allow Lockheed Martin Owego to expand its university partnerships, currently focused on electronics packaging, to include

Therefore, it is based on these facts, the potential new jobs, and the importance of retaining and enhancing Lockheed Martin in our community, it is the Department of Economic Development and Planning's recommendation to the IDA Board to allow sales tax exemption on this proposed project. There will be no mortgage tax abatement or real property tax abatement associated with the expansion project. Due to the sales tax exemption, the company will realize a benefit estimated at \$1,123,013. This savings, coupled with the State offered JDA package, will allow the Owego facility to be competitive with the other Lockheed Martin locations interested in housing the project.

That is the Economic Development and Planning recommendation to the IDA and I am happy to address any comments by the Board. Thank you.
