### **MINUTES APPROVAL**

The minutes for the November 5, 2020 meeting were reviewed by the committee. Mr. Standinger made a motion to approve the minutes as written and Mr. Balliet seconded the motion; the minutes were approved as written.

### SOLID WASTE

- 1. Ms. Pratt submitted the Solid Waste Reports for the month of November. Ms. Pratt reviewed these reports with the committee.
- 2. Ms. Pratt submitted the Solid Waste year-to-date budget summary.
- 3. Ms. Pratt started a discussion on recycling drop off options in light of transfer stations no longer accepting recycling. After a lengthy discussion, the committee decided that because there are a variety of vendors that offer curbside recycling pickup, no additional drop off locations will be provided.
