APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Legislator Mullen made a motion to approve the minutes of April 6, 2021; seconded by Legislator Hollenbeck, and so carried.

PROBATION:

Brian Cain, Probation Director, presented the following information to the committee. Reports are attached.

Budget:

On Track.

Issues:

- The Probation satellite office at the Village of Waverly Police Department is staffed full time, 5 days a week, as of April 5, 2021.
- Probation staff were presented with a framed COVID citation in recognition of their service to the citizens of Tioga County during the pad of the COVID pandemic. The citation was accompanied by a new probation badge and badge case to be used as identification during community interactions, professional functions, etc.
- Department has initiated a cross training initiative. This is an in-office series conducted at our joint staff meetings. The intent is to provide Officers with procedures regarding a specific facet of probation supervision (sex offender, DWI, domestic violence, report writing, mental health caseload, etc. As probation caseloads have become more specialized, this effort will allow for more flexibility for all Officers to be able to handle any type of case. Department is switching to a varied caseload instead of specialized.

- Marijuana Legislation New legislation impacts all facets of the criminal justice system, however, there appears to be no common approach to addressing the changes.
 Preliminary meeting with members of Probation, Sheriff's Dept. and District Attorneys' Office to begin working through some of the issues.
- Peer support staff from Trinity, ACBC, and Tioga County Alcohol and Drug Services are back in the Probation office. Peers schedule time to be at the Probation office every week to assist officer with probationers who have various need in addressing their addiction issues.
- Weekend Work Program will resume in June 2021. There is a list of who owes hours, individuals will report directly to worksites. They must show proof of Covid vaccine.
- Truancy Policy met with schools in county. District Attorney is in support of working on framework for Endangering Welfare of Child policy. Working with DSS/Schools/Probation and Legal Dept.
- Initiated file shredding oldest files (30-40 years old). 125 boxes in storage.
- A new vehicle may be necessary as well as arming of Officers. If they take individuals into custody, will need a caged vehicle (thinking ahead).

SHERIFF:

Sheriff Howard presented the following information to the committee. Reports are attached.

a) All positions are filled.

2. Corrections Division

- a) There is currently (4) open Corrections Officers positions.
- b) There is (1) part-time Cook position that remains open. (1) One full-time cook position will be open next month following Jeff Tiffany's retirement. We have a valid candidate for that position.
- c) We have two (2) Corrections Officers awaiting Medical Retirement.

3. Road Patrol

- a) Deputy out on 207C medical leave has returned to duty.
- b) There are no Deputies currently on light duty.
- c) We currently have (1) open Deputy position.

4. E911 Emergency Communications Center

a) There are currently (1) open E911 Dispatcher position.

5. Administration

a) All positions are filled.

Budget:

 Revenues are at \$157,046 which is 28% of the budget. Expenditures are at \$3,380,009, which is 38% of the budget. Inmate Boarders are at \$63,447 which is 42% of the budget.

OFFICE of EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Mike Simmons, OES Director, presented the following information to the committee. Report is attached.

Monthly Meetings Attended:

Zoom Meetings (Chiefs, EMS, EMO, S&R, HazMat) have been continuing.

Grants:

• Senator's grant for Training Room (MPR) Complete

Fire Services:

- Supported NYS Police and multiple fire departments at an incident that involved a vehicle, abandoned house, and approximately 75 acre forest fire.
- Fire Investigation Team responded to 6 fire calls, this is above average. Still investigating the Waverly warehouse fire.

EMS:

 Working with Personnel to update the job description and requirements for the position of EMS Coordinator. We are upgrading a requirement of having the certification of Paramedic of Advanced level of EMT. The coordinator sits on SREMS Board. Need to raise wage from minimum wages vs. ambulance (\$25/\$30hr).

Emergency Services:

- Communications and Radio System:
 - Still experiencing problems with radio system. Both the Sheriff's 911 dispatch channel continues to go dead intermittently for about 5 minutes during each outage. The Owego Police channel experiences similar outages. Tri-County has not been able to locate the problem.
 - A letter was sent to Tri-County informing them that we will be discontinuing the service plan we have with them on May 22nd, 2021. Capital Communications of Harrisburg, PA has been contracted to fix the current problems and to respond to any outages. Capital Area Communications have technicians available from the Athens, PA area. Tri-County has removed their property from Dispatch.
 - NYSTEC is continuing to prepare documents to present to the state to support our grant application. NYSTEC has presented us with a quote to have them continue providing technical assistance as we continue to advance through the radio project. This quote to continue is \$117,855.28. (resolution attached)
 - Central New York Radio Consortium is based in Onondaga County with most counties in region being a member. This allows shared radio frequencies and standard operating procedures for all 911 Centers. Tompkins and Tioga Counties are only non-members at this time. Coverage is from PA border to Canada. Costs are dispersed within the consortium. Broome County costs decreased from \$300,000 to \$40,000. If cable is cut, system reverts back to standard radio system and still works. Expect \$1.3M savings first year. Some of Tioga County dead spots will switch/roam to closest tower available.
 - As we have discussed in previous meetings, the CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) system is in various states of failure. Within the radio system contract the CAD is

included but cannot be purchased with SICG money. Currently there is enough money in the 911 Surcharge funds to purchase the CAD portion. That amount is approximately \$847,500 for the CAD, and \$116,000 for the Digital Evidence Management program.

Public Safety Committee Meeting Probation Department Report May 4, 2021

Budget Status:

2021 Revenue Budget:

- ATI plan has been approved and executed for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.
- Collections: DWI Supervision fee- down 3% from anticipated amount
- \$20,348 in restitution collected during first quarter

2021 Budget: On target

Issues:

- The Probation satellite office embedded in the Village of Waverly Police Department was staffed full time beginning April 5, 2021 as previously anticipated. The officers manning the office have full office capabilities. When not meeting with probationers or working on other office functions, the officers have been instructed to engage various community members to establish a better rapport with our community partners.
- 2. On April 22, 2021, at a full staff meeting, all staff were presented with a framed COVID Citation in recognition of their service to the citizens of Tioga County during the peak of the COVID pandemic. The Citation was accompanied by a new probation badge and badge case to be used as identification during community interactions, professional functions, etc.
- 3. The Department initiated the Probation Cross Training initiative at our last staff meeting. The Cross Training initiative is an in office training series conducted at our joint staff meetings. The intent is to provide Officers with procedures regarding a specific facet of probation supervision (sex offender supervision, DWI, Domestic Violence, Report Writing, Mental Health caseload, etc.) As probation caseloads have become more specialized, this effort will allow for more flexibility in a small Department such as ours where it is necessary for all Officers to be able to handle any type of case. At the end of each training module, each PO receives a "Cheat Sheet" in order to build a library of quick reference tools should they need to refer to it in the future.
- 4. Marijuana Legislation This Director met with the Council of Probation Administrators (COPA) in April to discuss the newly passed Legalization of Recreational Marijuana. The Legislation impacts all facets of the criminal justice system however to date there appears to be no common approach to addressing the changes. Members of the Probation Department, Tioga County Sheriff's Office, and District Attorney's Office had a preliminary meeting on April 21, 2021 to begin to work through some of the issues.
- 5. COVID Vaccinations: Probation Officers fall under 1b provisions. To date, over 75% of probation staff are either partially or fully vaccinated.
- 6. In conjunction with the appropriate records retention schedule, a purge of old probation files has been initiated. In addition to the future scanning of all probation files to be stored in a digital form, extremely old files (30 years or more) are being shredded with only the most essential records being scanned and saved. There are currently in excess of 125 boxes of old probation files in long term storage, most of which are beyond the mandated records retention standards.
- 7. Peer support staff from Trinity, ACBC, and Tioga County Alcohol and Drug Services are back in the Probation office. Peers schedule time to be at the Probation office every week to assist officers with probationers who have various needs in addressing their addiction issues.

8. Juvenile Delinquency Services:

April 2021- Probation received four JD tickets, two were charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child, one with Assault, and one with Criminal Obstruction of Breathing. All charges were the Misdemeanor level. Three of the four matters are in the process of being diverted. One of the matters was referred immediately for petition.

YTD: 8 JDATs received to date.

- E- Connect: 8 youth screened. Two determined to be a Level 3 risk (low) for suicide ideation, two Level 2 risk (medium), one Level 1 risk (high), and three below threshold for mental health services.
- Alternative to Detention Programing: Probation contracts with Cayuga Counseling for our Juvenile Specialized Supervision Program (JSSP). The Program is currently at maximum capacity, servicing eight youth. The program has established a waiting list of youth who have been referred. The Program continues to work with our youth at risk of either being placed in detention or in the custody of the Tioga County Department of Social Services.
- Decision Points- planning continues for a pilot program to be provided to at risk students in the Tioga Central School District in the Fall of 2021. Trained Probation Staff will provide the program in the school as part of an alternative to expulsion program the school runs.
 - Probation continues to support and make referrals to ACBC as their Making Our Success Sustainable (M.O.S.S.) Program continues to grow. Probation currently has seven youth participating in the program.
- We have six youth currently in juvenile sex offender treatment.

<u>ATI Programs</u>: The Tioga County ATI Plan was submitted to the State on 2/25/21 and has been approved and executed. Tioga has also received a waiver for an additional year to operate the PTR program absent of a validated risk assessment tool. The initial waiver was granted last year and has been extended another year while jurisdictions search for an assessment tool that the state will approve.

- * Electronic Monitoring Have no units in use at this time.
- <u>Community Service</u> Probation has been given approval to resume the Weekend Work Program. Officers are in the process of establishing a list of probationers who need to complete WWP hours for the courts. WWP crews have not been active since 3/1/20.
- Pre-Trial Release Pre-Trial Release In 2020, Probation was given provisional approval to run Pre-Trial Release in Tioga County. The provisional level was due to our lack of an assessment tool that meets the stipulations of the law. As mentioned last year Probation does not have the funding to purchase and norm an assessment tool with a local university that meetings the statute's requirements.

Court Ordered Investigations: 29 active investigations for Tioga County courts (Criminal, Family and Surrogate)

Supervision: 220 cases ordered by Tioga County courts & Family Court (includes JD Diversion cases)

Violation of Probation petitions: 24 defendants/respondents have violation petitions pending against them in criminal & family court.
