    - Currently do 24/7 Telehealth crisis
  - $\circ$  \$150,000 of the \$600,000 already received
  - A car will need to be purchased for Mental Health
  - Program requires a minimum of one licensed individual to cover: Lori thinking two additional staff
  - o Program has to be sustainable after two years
  - Looking at rates for each service provided
  - Goal is to work with community partners to develop plan
- Budget
  - o No new news
- Suicide Coalition
  - Under A New Hope Center Now
  - May hire someone part-time to run
- Waverly Site
  - o Formal plan in development
  - o Meeting last Thursday
  - o County is funding the building rehabilitation
  - Looking for a 20-year lease
  - Agreed to a 1% increase per year for rent
  - Rate is the same as the previous Waverly location
  - o Renovation to go out to bid with County Public Works
