APPROVAL OF MARCH 7TH MINUTES

Motion by Legislator Brown, seconded by Legislator Standinger, all in favor, carried.

FINANCIAL

YTD Budget Report was presented. No discussion.

OLD BUSINESS

Refer to March Minutes.

Designating petition filing in progress. As of last week, the State extended the filing deadline from April 6th to April 10th due to the Passover holiday.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Wahls met with the Tioga County Treasurer, Personnel Officer, and staff from both departments on March 24th to discuss how to best comply with IRS tax reporting requirements for election inspectors (poll workers) moving forward. It was concluded that election inspectors should all be paid as county employees, but the details are to be determined this year and take effect in 2024. The committee noted that this could be a significant barrier to recruitment, as well as an additional expense, due to all the mandatory trainings required of county employees and was interested to know if anyone has reached out to Roemer's law office for advisement. Commissioner Wahls will find out.

The Board of Elections IMS server has been experiencing intermittent communication issues with the NYSVoter database, which has been ongoing for months. County ITCS is coordinating with the NYS Board of Elections network team to try to identify the cause.

New Election Inspector Training is scheduled for April 17th and 19th. After contacting prospective poll workers and only getting a few sign-ups, we sent a press release to the local newspapers for additional recruitment.

To prepare for the upcoming training classes and June primary, we have begun ePollbook maintenance procedures which should improve ePollbook performance. This will take time as we have 68 units, and it takes about 2 hrs per unit.

Following petition filing, we will know more about which offices in Tioga County will have primary races. The BOE must certify the primary ballot by May 4th.

RESOLUTION NO. -23 AUTHORIZE AGREEMENT WITH FRSECURE LLC. FOR INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL CYBER SECURITY PENETRATION TESTING

WHEREAS: The Chief Information Officer and the Deputy Director of ITCS have completed a search for qualified organizations to complete the annual internal and external Information Security penetration testing of the Tioga County Information Technology Infrastructure; and

WHEREAS: The Chief Information Officer and the Deputy Director of ITCS are recommending an agreement with FRSECURE, LLC to complete robust testing of current internal and external Information Security controls; and

WHEREAS: The penetration testing services will be purchased using the OMNIA Partners Cooperative Purchasing program using the reseller company, SHI; and

WHEREAS: Funding will be provided for using Board of Elections Grant funds H1450 520620 CYBER; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Chair of the County Legislature is authorized to execute an agreement between Tioga County and FRSECURE, LLC in the amount of \$22,276.80 to provide robust internal and external penetration testing and reporting, upon review by the County Attorney.
