- Flu & RSV are the new hot topics
 - o Kids being hit hardest
 - People going to Walk-ins & ERs because they cannot get into see their regular doctors.
 - They are experiencing staffing issues like everyone else
 - Public Health is using a medical reserve core to assist with vaccinations and such.
 - Working on contract details with the Core
 - Dr. Bezirganian has offered to assist Public Health in the interim.

- Fran has hired several people

- Subcontracting with DSS to do the CAC
