• COVID discussed briefly

- Home testing is not counted in numbers, only office
   PCR tests making it difficult to obtain actual real numbers
- Flu & RSV are the new hot topics
  - o Kids being hit hardest
  - People going to Walk-ins & ERs because they cannot get into see their regular doctors.
  - o They are experiencing staffing issues like everyone else
  - Public Health is using a medical reserve core to assist with vaccinations and such.
  - o Working on contract details with the Core
  - Dr. Bezirganian has offered to assist Public Health in the interim.

A New Hope Center – Fran Bialy

- Fran has hired several people
  - o One position remains to be filled
- Subcontracting with DSS to do the CAC
- DSS Tina Lounsbury
  - Four new people started in November in Services
    - Housing
      - o Still a huge issue in the county
      - o Deep Well is advertising rooms for the homeless
      - o Still have people living in tents
      - o Fran is seeing the issue as well
        - Rooms are being occupied for longer periods of time
      - o Housing discussed in detail
- Other
  - Fran will be participating in a PIT Count in January & February
    - Going to places outside of shelters to try and obtain a count of the homeless
