FINANCIAL:

FINANCIAL:

• Expended 90% of 2024 budget.

OLD BUSINESS:

- One open Probation Officer position
- All Probation Officers completed their 21 hours of mandated training in 2024.
- Electronic Monitoring: Currently there are four individuals being monitored.
- Took delivery of new 2023 Dodge Durango.
- Probation members worked with Veteran's Services and the Rotary at a Veteran's Grocery Giveaway at Catholic Charities, more than 50 Veterans and their families benefitted from the giveaway.
- WWP: Currently suspended pending further court orders.
- Pre-Trial Release: there are 37 people being supervised.
- Court Ordered Investigations: 51 active cases opened.
- Supervising: 176 people currently.

NEW BUSINESS:

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Public Safety Committee Meeting Probation Department Report February 4, 2025

Budget Status:

2025 Revenue Budget:

- \$900 of DWI Supervision fee collected in January. \$900 collected in 2025
- \$2,525.14 in restitution and surcharge collected in January. \$2,525.14 collected in 2025

Current Business:

- 1. Staffing One open Probation Officer position remains unfilled. At this time there have been no applications submitted to Personnel for review.
- Training All Probation staff now meet the state required training curriculum. Probation
 supervisory staff will be attending a Threat Assessment Management training in February to
 learn the procedures to report threats via the app being used by Tioga County. Officers are
 also scheduling their attendance at training regarding Drug Treatment Court in March in
 Saratoga Springs.
- 3. Probation staff survey. The Probation staff survey was completed and the results reviewed at the January Probation staff meeting. The survey will be used to create dialogue and move the Probation Department forward
- 4. Atlas Digital Platform Probation brought forth a resolution which was adopted by the Legislature which allows Probation to enter into a three-year contract with The Change Company to access their Evidence Based digital programs for use with both the Adult and Juvenile populations in Tioga County. The aggregate cost of the contract is slightly more than \$12,000 and will be funded with Pretrial Release Award money as well as Floyd Hooker Foundation money. Probation intends to include a percentage of the cost of the contract in the 2025-2026 Raise the Age Plan which would reimburse Tioga County 100% for the RTA juveniles who utilize the modules.

Update: Probation now needs to receive approval by IT prior to the signing of the contract and submit another Resolution to the Legislature.

- 5. Probation is beginning to schedule trainings to our local Law Enforcement Agencies, the Tioga County Department of Social Services, the Courts and other organizations throughout Tioga County regarding the duties of the Probation Department and what resources we have to offer.
- 6. Probation has initiated a program which identifies a Primary and Secondary Officer for each specialty caseload (DWI, Sex Offender, Domestic Violence, Mental Health, Interstate Transfer, Pre-Trial Release, and Electronic Monitoring).
- 7. Southern Tier Training Academy
- 8. Intensive Supervision Program
- 9. IT approval for Change Companies Resolution

10. <u>Juvenile Delinquency Services</u>:

January of 2025- There were two Juvenile Delinquency Appearance Tickets (JDAT) received for the month of January. The JDATs alleged the respondents committed acts which if committed by an adult would constitute the crimes of Criminal Mischief and Reckless Endangerment, all Misdemeanor level offenses.

YTD: 2 JDATs received to date.

- E- Connect: To date, Two (2) youth have been screened in 2025. As a result of the E-Connect screenings, one (1) youth was found to be below threshold and not in need of an immediate mental health referral. One (1) youth was found to be a level II and was referred for a mental health evaluation. Zero (0) youth were found to be a level III and agreed to schedule an appointment at TCDMH. Zero (0) youth were also determined to be a level I which required immediate mental health intervention.
- There are currently three youth participating in juvenile sex offender treatment.

ATI Programs:

- <u>Electronic Monitoring</u> There are currently four individuals being monitored via the VCheck24 phone app, GPS electronic monitoring system, and AlcoTag systems.
- <u>Community Service</u> WWP is currently suspended. When more orders for community service on the WWP are received, operation of the WWP will resume.
- <u>Pre-Trial Release</u> There are 31 people being supervised via the Pre-Trial Release program

Court Ordered Investigations: 49 active investigations for Tioga County courts (Criminal, Family and Surrogate)

Supervision: 176 cases ordered by Tioga County courts & Family Court (includes JD Diversion cases)

Violation of Probation petitions: 17 defendants/respondents have violation petitions pending against them in criminal & family court.
