RESOLUTION NO. -24 AUTHORIZE SUBMISSION OF STATEWIDE INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATIONS FORMULA GRANT APPLICATION (SICG24) OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS: The Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has issued a Statewide Interoperable Communications Formula Grant 2024. The grant will be used for the maintenance and upgrading of the radio communications in the county and no local share is associated with said grant; and

WHEREAS: County Policy requires that permission be obtained prior to submitting said application; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Tioga County Office of Emergency Services be authorized to submit the Statewide Interoperable Communications Formula Grant 2024 application and authorizes the Chair of the Legislature to sign any and all grant related paperwork upon review by the County Attorney.

Old Business:

Radio Project:

Motorola completed site testing the week of April 8th, boring holes to conduct soil samples. We are still awaiting the final report. Campville Fire assisted with providing water at some of the tower locations. There was a miscommunication between the point of contact and the subcontractor utilized for needs while on site but all testing was completed.

MNI came out with Motorola April 30th-May 2nd to update the microwave study to ensure all coverage will continue to match the path studies conducted previously.

Bob Williams is working with Senator O'Mara's office to renew the Shirley Rd tower lease. This must be a state law as it is on state property. The current lease expires in 2026.

CAD Project:

NYSP and Candor EMS are live on the map. Other EMS agencies are working to join the CAD system. As is Candor Village PD.

EMS:

No significant changes in county EMS coverage. The same issues continue to exist in regards to manpower shortages.

Emergency Management:

There were no issues associated with the Solar Eclipse.

The 17 paving project is underway. Apalachin Fire Dept. has created a response plan for incidents that occur while the highway has limited access.

There are also paving projects that will be completed on 38B in Newark Valley.

Threat Assessment Team:

We put out an RFP for a threat assessment reporting app. There is a resolution to accept a bid from MYEMO.

TAM trainings have been conducted and are scheduled for May to continue to get all stakeholders trained appropriately.

Fire: Fire departments have continued to be very busy.

The Spring Burn Ban is in effect currently (runs from March 16 to May 15).

Myself, David Churchman and Bob Williams attended the Fire Coordinator's Conference in Watkins Glen. This conference had updates to changes in the fire service, including potentially impactful OSHA changes that have been proposed.

The HAZMAT team received a donation of a fuel transfer pump from Scott Smith and Son to help them off-load leaking tanks. We will be working on a press-release for this shortly to thank Scott Smith and Son.
