A. L. Tinney Report: Ms. Tinney provided the board with a written report of ED&P's current activities. Ms. Curtis provided a summary of Ms. Tinney's report to the board, including project updates and discussion regarding the administration fee from the DRI projects.

Dear TCIDA Board of Directors,

Since 2022, Best Bev, LLC has been engaged in the renovation and equipping of 685 Broad Street Ext Waverly, NY 14892 for providing co-packing, material sourcing, storage and brand distributions for beverage brands. The company projected an overall investment of 22.9 million in improvements and equipment while creating 65 full-time equivalent jobs.

The project is now estimated to be more than 35 million in improvements and equipment costs to maximize the potential at the 685 Broad Street facility. One of the large unanticipated improvements was related to the modern-day water and waste treatment (\$3,440,000) required for connection to the municipality. Our goal of hiring 65 full-time employees has already been surpassed and we are anticipating hiring up to 160 full-time employees. Due to the local support and staffing success, we are exploring the concept of closing our Pennsylvania facility production and transferring all capacity to the Waverly warehouse.

We are asking the board to keep the current termination date of February 1, 2024 but increase our sales tax exemption to help lower the burden of finalizing our project while we focus on hiring and training new employees. To date, we spent \$13, 395, 675.81 on goods related to the Project and subject to New York State and local sales and use taxes, resulting in an exemption amount of \$1,071,654.06

The revised estimated total purchase of goods relating to the Project and subject to New York State and local sales and use taxes is \$20,246, 891 and, therefore, the revised total sales tax exemptions requested is \$1,619,751.28(8% of total purchases)
